CLOSER RELATIONSHIPS



"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!" (2 Corinthians 5:17).

How can we Build CLOSER RELATIONSHIPS?

- o Accept right up front, no relationship is perfect. I'M not -You're Not Were Not
- Be PRESENT listen to hear, not listen to respond.
- Clarify your personal expectations What is <u>realistic</u> and <u>unrealistic</u>
 Enter each relationship as <u>a server</u>, not a <u>taker</u>
 Ensure your Foundations are Strong and Godly built F.R.E.D.L.R.

- o Engage in Wholesome Biblical Relationships that BUILD us, not pull us down.
- Appreciate /relate according to the level of spiritual maturity (false expectations)
 1Cor 2:14
- o BE Fitted into the body of Christ that ENCOURAGES US and brings us to MATURITY

- Committed to investing into one another thus extending the Kingdom
 Being an outlet for the gospel of Jesus Christ
 In Conversations Apply the F.O.R.D technique Family- Occupation Recreation –
- Time and adversity Prov 17:17 A friend is always loyal, and a brother is born to help in time of need.
- Don't expect a reward, thanks, or "like kind" if it comes then great!
- o Above all else, SERVE others before yourself
