What Is Pastoral Care?

Pastoral Care is a comprehensive course designed to equip those who identify with the gifts essential in pastoral care. Mercy, grace, helps, and a genuine care for people are essential in developing a heart to serve others. The course follows the Lay Pastors Guide by Frank Damazio, and helps provide a support structure which builds practical and ethical frameworks in which to care and serve our community.

PASTORAL CARE will equip you to act!

PASTORAL CARE is about being aware of the needs around us (spirit soul and body), and being equipped to help.

Not everyone is gifted this way, so this course is not ideal for everyone. In fact applicants must be assessed and gifted to be enrolled and able to participate.

The curriculum requires:

- Homework
- Practicum
- Study
- Coaching
- Commitment

The semesters follow University terms (4), and completion of each term is a requirement to continue into the next term.

It is anticipated successful candidates will play a significant role in church life.

WHAT IS PASTORAL CARE?

A small growth group, set in a social environment, where people with an interest in developing their gifts and understanding of pastoral care and their plan for life.

IS IT SUITABLE FOR ME?

The discussions and teaching centre around structured Biblical principles of care and support.

How does it work?

Held one evening per week for 90 minutes in a small group meeting. A full curriculum manual is provided for selected students.

IS THERE A COST?

Each term costs \$32.00 or a total cost of \$128 per course. Includes manual and resources.
