

PULPIT PRESENCE	MESSAGE CONTENT
First and foremost, the microphone should be central to the conversation – Hold it close to your mouth and keep it within 3-4 inches.	Don't bombard with content. Seek the Holy Spirits guidance and be clear on what the thought is to share.
Secondly, it's a message of encouragement to thank God with our Tithes and offerings as an act of worship. We must approach it that way.	Read the scripture out. Use power point if you want but keep the point clear and focused. Have it printed out to read from or memorized.
Thirdly, scripture is the basis of our growth and maturity. If we present Gods word faithfully, it will bring the conviction and direction,	Don't confuse your content. Better one clear thought than three or four options. Remember, we are encouraging people in God's word
Fourthly, sharing Gods word is a privilege and trust. We are accountable with responsibility. Keep the main thing the main thing and within the time-frame granted.	It it's clear to you, it's clear to the hearer. Your content should be at hand. Don't fumble through bible or notepad to find it. Lay it out in front of you and have your glasses – bible at hand
Fifthly, preparation honours God and the hearer. We have seven days before the offering message, take time to seek His word	Don't waffle or go off topic. No introduction is necessary; use your time wisely, as others will follow after your talk.
Sixthly, prayer, prayer, prayer. Don't ad-lib, it doesn't honour God. Think it, write it, share it. Someone needs to hear the heart of God.	The giving message is powerful in teaching people about faith and family. Let the power of scripture do the work in people's hearts.
<p>Finally, stay on topic. It's not a sermon it's a thought to share on giving- sowing –investing as an act of worship.
