Why CLUB 180?

CLUB 180 gets its name from a principle recorded in the Bible. Every person that chooses to become a Christian has to make a series of decisions. The first decision is to acknowledge we are walking down a path which takes us away from God. We choose to halt that direction, ask for forgiveness and turn 180° and head off in the opposite direction. **CLUB 180** provides guidance and support in making that turn.

CLUB 180 will equip you to act!

The word repentance means to literally stop in your tracks, recognise that the direction you are bound for is wrong, turn around and move off in the opposite direction.

By changing our mind (not just our opinion), and with a new appreciation for God's direction for our life, we turn our thinking into God's thinking.

To repent of some thing is to admit that you have offended God. The basis of our relationship is forged in His forgiveness and unconditional love for us.
